Once selected, the participants have to report duty as requested by the Scout Centres. Failure to report duty or comply with Centre's regulations and/or directions will be considered as a disciplinary matter and will be subject to immediate suspension of participation in the event and compulsory return to Hong Kong by the International Commissioner, followed by investigation. He/she may be prohibited from taking part in future international events. Age of participants is calculated on the 1st day of the service period concerned. Applicants are required to attend an interview. Applicants must be able to communicate fluently in English. Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and travelling insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable) as well as any personal expenses.
