

## Messengers of Peace – Hong Kong

This Circular supersedes International Circular No. 09/2020 issued on 15 March 2020.

The World Scout Committee launched the World Scouting’s Messengers of Peace (MoP) Initiative since 2011 with the aims of inspiring millions of Scouts who are doing amazing things in their local communities to tell the world about it, thus inspiring other Scouts to do even more. Any Scout project that brings a positive change in a community - its health, environment, social circumstances, safety or addresses conflict - is a Messengers of Peace project.

### MoP Projects in Hong Kong

We encourage Scout units (including Scout groups and districts) to organize MoP projects. Requirements are as below:

- (1) The project should be in line with any theme of “Messengers of Peace”
- (2) The project should contain service element and each participant should render at least one hour of service to the community

### MoP Badge

In order to recognize the contribution of individual Scouts, with effective from 1 December 2014, members of the Scout Association of Hong Kong who have participated in any MoP projects registered at WOSM SDGs website (<https://sdgs.scout.org/>) and recognized by our Association will receive a MoP Badge Coupon. Youth members are allowed to wear the MoP Badge (shown on the right) on their Scout uniform until being promoted to another Scout section. They should participate in another recognized MoP project after being promoted to another section in order to continue wearing the badge. Adult members are allowed to wear the MoP Badge on their Scout uniform for 12 months, starting from the first day of the MoP project. If they participate in another recognized MoP project, they are allowed to continue wearing the badge for another 12 months.

### Project Workflow (Please refer to the “Flow Chart of Messengers of Peace (MoP) Project (02/2023)” for more details)

1. Submission of Project Proposal
  - i. For Projects that USE the MoP logo in circulars / souvenirs / promotional materials  
→ Submit application to the MoP coordinator of the respective unit. **【Step 1】**
  - ii. For Projects that DO NOT USE the MoP logo in circulars / souvenirs / promotional materials.  
→ Implement the project. **【Step 2】**

(If the project is organized by more than one Scout units, application should be submitted to any MoP Coordinator from organizing units for approval. If the related Region/Unit have not yet appointed a MoP Coordinator, the application can be submitted to International Branch.)

2. Implementation of the MoP Project. **【Step 2】**

3. Leader-in-charge should register for a Personal Account (for first time registration only) **【Step 3】**
4. Upon completion of the Project, upload the Project Report and submit the “Badge Purchase Request Form” to the respective Branches / Regions or International Branch. **【Step 4】**
5. After approval is granted, a MoP Badge Coupon will be issued. Applicants can purchase the MoP Badge at The Scout Shop of Hong Kong upon presentation of the Badge Coupon. Each MoP Badge costs HK\$5. **【Step 5】**

### **Badge Wearing Position**

The MoP Badge should be worn in the middle of the left pocket of the Scout uniform (i.e. position of the Membership Badge). If Scout members are wearing MoP Badge, the Membership Badge is not required to wear. For details, please refer to the “Uniform Handbook” which will be updated from time to time.

### **Overseas MoP Projects**

For Overseas MoP Projects, members can submit their application to International Branch for approval after completion of the project.

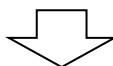
### **1. Submission of Project Proposal**

- **For projects that use the MoP logo in circulars / souvenirs / promotional materials**

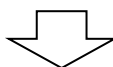
For proper use of MoP design, Leader-in-charge shall submit a project proposal 【Form: MoP/01】 and draft design(s) of circular / souvenirs / promotional materials to the MoP Coordinator of your respective unit (see page 2) for approval at least two weeks before the publication date. Leader-in-charge can proceed to step 2 and implement the proposed MoP Project after approval. - **For projects that do not use the MoP logo in circulars / souvenirs / promotional materials**

Leader-in-charge can proceed to step 2 and implement the proposed MoP Project.

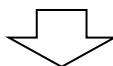


### **3. Personal Account Registration**

During the implementation or after completion of the MoP project, Leader-in-charge has to create his / her personal profiles at the website of World Organization of the Scout Movement (<https://scout.org/>) for submission of the Project Report. (see page 3)

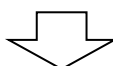
*Only need to register once and can be used for other MoP Projects in the future.*



### **4. Submission of Project Report**

After completion of the MoP project, Leader-in-charge:

- (i) Reports the project details and upload photos / video at WOSM SDGs website (<https://sdgs.scout.org/>) (see page 4) and
- (ii) sends the URL of the Project (<https://sdgs.scout.org/project/xxxxxx>) (see page 7) with the above-mentioned information uploaded, together with the Badge Purchase Request Form【Form: MoP/02】, to the respective Branches / Regions by email or mail for verification.



**5. Purchase of MoP Badge (HKD5.00 each)**

- (i) For Individuals (For activities organized by AHQ units and Regions only) – Participants use the Individual MoP Badge Coupon to purchase the Badge at the Scout Shop.
- (ii) For Unit – Leader-in-charge can use the Group MoP Badge Coupon to purchase the Badge at the Scout Shop for all participants.

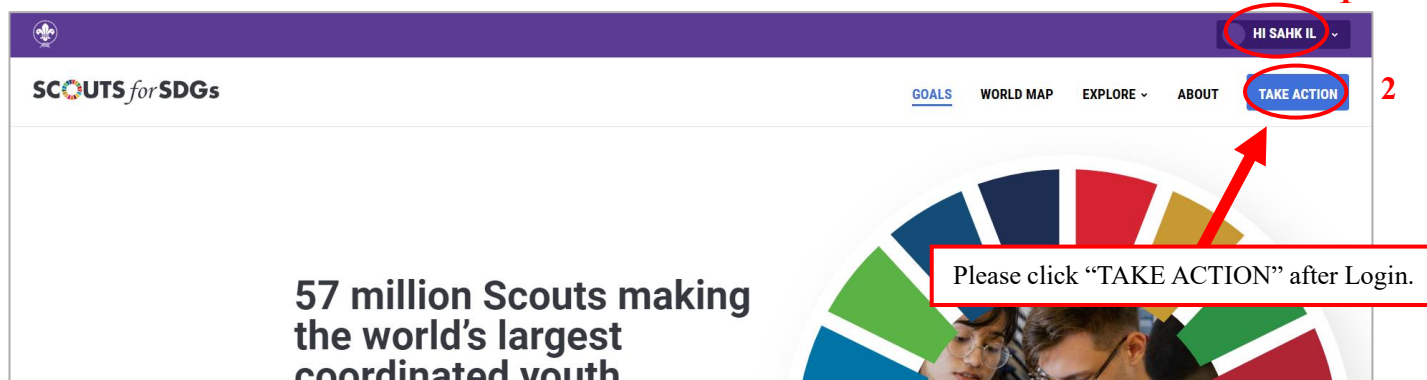








### Items to Prepare

1. Name of your project (max. 50 characters)
2. Details of your project (date, location, number of participants, number of beneficiaries)
3. Reason for doing the project (max. 500 characters)
4. How the project was carried out (max. 500 characters)
5. What impacts the project brought (max. 500 characters)
6. Lessons learned (max. 500 characters)
7. At least ONE photo of your project

2	<p><b>Topics</b></p> <p>Choose 3 key terms and SDGs that best describe your project.</p> <p>Note: based on the topics that you have chosen, the website will automatically filter the SDGs given.</p>	

<p>3</p> <p><b><u>Date and Location</u></b></p> <p>Input the key information of the project: the date and location of the function</p>		
<p>4</p> <p><b><u>Details</u></b></p> <p>Also input number of participants and number of project beneficiaries.</p>		
<p>5</p> <p><b><u>Motivation</u></b></p> <p>Write a few lines on your reason of doing the project. (max. 500 characters)</p>		
<p>6</p> <p><b><u>Execution</u></b></p> <p>Write a few lines on how the project was done. (max. 500 characters)</p>		
<p>7</p> <p><b><u>Impact</u></b></p> <p>Write a few lines on the project's impact. (max. 500 characters)</p>		

<p>8</p> <p><b><u>Learnings</u></b></p> <p>Write a few lines on the lessons learnt from the project. (max. 500 characters)</p>		
<p>9</p> <p><b><u>Photos</u></b></p> <p>Include at least one cover photo for the project. You can also add extra photos to the “gallery”. Please make sure that you have permission from the people in the photos before posting.</p>		
<p>10</p> <p><b><u>Title</u></b></p> <p>Add a title for your project (note: this can be your project name) (max. 50 characters)</p>		
<p>11</p> <p><b><u>Preview</u></b></p> <p>Your project will then be uploaded for a review process. It will be automatically published afterwards.</p>
