#### **B.** Competition Requirements

- 1. i. Each team consists of 1 commander, 1 flag raiser and 1 escort. One extra member can be reserved for taking over any post of the team (All team members should be from the same unit [Region, District, Scout Group or Pack/Troop/Unit/Crew]). The team will be disqualified or be withdrawn from the competition when the participating team members (including the commander) are less than 3 people.
  - ii. All team members should have basic knowledge in footdrill.
- 2. Each team should assign at least 1 representative to attend the Briefing Session at 8:00 pm on 10 October 2023 (Tuesday) at Hong Kong Scout Centre. The team will be disqualified in case of NO representative attending the Briefing Session.
- 3. Winning teams must attend both the Rehearsal on 28 October 2023 (Saturday) and the Scout Rally on 29 October 2023 (Sunday) or else the ranking of the team will be deprived.
- 4. Uniform Requirement: All team members should wear full uniform in the competition. Details are as follows:

## **Cub Scouts** and Scouts:

Male: Hat, scarf, short sleeves shirt, belt, shorts, stockings, black laced shoes.

Female: Hat, scarf, short sleeves shirt, belt, culottes, stockings, black laced shoes.

## Venture Scouts, Rover Scouts and Leaders:

Hat, scarf, short sleeves shirt, belt, trousers, black socks, black laced shoes.

Remark: No boots or black laced shoes with heel plates/hobnail are allowed in the competition.

- 5. Marking Scheme: Uniform, marching movement, performance of the commander, performance of hoisting flag and time control will all be counted.
- 6. Disputes should be submitted to Rally Organizer in writing within the time period specified. Rally Organizer and Chief Judge will make the final judgment.
- 7. Competition requirements are subject to change when the Rally Organizing Committee deems necessary for special circumstances.

### **B.** Competition Requirements

- 1. i. Each team at least consists of 1 commander, 1 colour bearer and 10 members (Team members should be composed of Scout, Venture Scout, Rover Scout or leader of the same unit [Region, District, Scout Group or Troop/Unit/Crew]). Each team may have 2 extra members and each extra member can earn 3 additional points. The team will be disqualified or be withdrawn from the competition when the participating team members (including the commander & colour bearer) are less than 12 people.
  - ii. All team members should have basic knowledge in footdrill.
- 2. Each team should assign at least 1 representative to attend the Briefing Session at 7:30 pm on 10 October 2023 (Tuesday) at Hong Kong Scout Centre. The team will be disqualified in case of NO representative attending the Briefing Session.
- 3. Each team must attend both the Rehearsal on 22 October 2023 (Sunday) and the March Past on the Scout Rally on 29 October 2023 (Sunday). If any team fails to do so or cannot fulfill the competition requirements, the ranking of the team will be deprived.
- 4. Uniform Requirement: All team members should wear full uniform in the competition. Details are as follows:

#### Scouts:

Male: Hat, scarf, short sleeves shirt, belt, shorts, stockings, black laced shoes. Female: Hat, scarf, short sleeves shirt, belt, culottes, stockings, black laced shoes.

#### Venture Scouts, Rover Scouts and Leaders:

Hat, scarf, short sleeves shirt, belt, trousers, black socks, black laced shoes.

Remark: No boots or black laced shoes with heel plates/hobnail are allowed in the competition.

- 5. Marking Scheme: 80% for the movements in the halt and movements in quick time; 20% for uniform.
- 6. Disputes should be submitted to Rally Organizer in writing within the time period specified. Rally Organizer and Chief Judge will make the final judgment.
- 7. Competition requirements are subject to change when the Rally Organizing Committee deems necessary for special circumstances.
