Substation Registration

To promote connections among Scout members through communication technologies, Scout units, e.g. Scout Groups, Scout Districts and Regions, are encouraged to set up their own JOTA-JOTI substations so that their members may participate in the event at their own venues.

Units may organize JOTA-JOTI activities at their own venues without registration. Nonetheless, registered substations will receive the following supports from the International Branch:

- Provision of latest international news and updates on JOTA-JOTI;
- Early subscription of JOTA-JOTI souvenir badges and souvenirs;
- Activity updates will be posted at [activity website](#) for promotion.

To register as a substation, each Scout Unit must be a Scout Unit recognized by Scout Association of Hong Kong, and must undertake:

- To organize telecommunication-related and with the theme of “Youth Leadership in Peace” substation activities for at least 3 hours during the JOTA-JOTI event (Friday to Sunday, 20-22 October 2023);
- Except those with special approval from the Organizing Committee, the substation activities should NOT be part of the unit’s own function / programme (e.g. Celebration of Group Anniversary).
- To establish connection with the AHQ Station or overseas Scout Units approved by International Branch by at least 2 of the following channels:
 - ✧ Amateur Radio
 - ✧ Scoutlink IRC / Facebook
 - ✧ Other appropriate communication activities proposed by the substation and accepted by the International Branch; and
- To submit a brief report with at least 10 photographs within 2 weeks after the event.
