



## **Integration Arrangement of Scoutcraft Training**

*This Circular supersedes Policy Circular No.02/2019 issued on 15 December 2019.*

In order to encourage members to continue their Scoutcraft training and make good use of training resources, when youth members become leaders, through collaboration between related Branches, they are not required to repeat Scoutcraft training they received during their youth member period, and have more time to participate in other training that they have not yet received. This arrangement will equip themselves as well as enable youth members to experience the best Scouting life, thus respond to the Association's "Strategic Plan (2024-2027)".

After trial period and reviewed, the revised integration arrangement of Scoutcraft training is listed as the following:

<b>Holding of Certificate issued on or after 1 September 2014</b>	<b>Equivalent to holding of Leaders' Certificate</b>
Certificate of Venture Scout / Rover Scout Map Reading Course	Certificate of Map Reading Course
Certificate of Venture Scout / Rover Scout Expedition Course	Certificate of Expedition Course
Certificate of Venture Scout Activity Bar	Certificate of Campcraft Course

The above arrangement is applicable to the Core and Elective Leader Skill Courses of the Wood Badge Training Scheme, i.e. exemption from taking related Leader Skill Course is accepted.
