

**ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE SCOUT RAFFLE CAMPAIGN 2025  
(For Silver Jubilee District)**

As in the past years, the annual Scout Raffle Campaign will be held in the spring of 2025 raising funds to help Units of the Association. Details of the Campaign are as follows:

Selling Period : 19 January 2025 (Sunday) to 7 March 2025 (Friday)  
Date for Raffle Draw : 15 March 2025 (Saturday)  
Selling Price : HK\$10 each

To encourage Scout Groups to participate in the Raffle Campaign, three awards viz. “**Best Performance Award**”, “**Best Per Capita Performance Award**” and “**Best Improvement Award**” are set up in recognition of the Groups’ efforts.

**Scout Raffle Campaign 2025**  
**Rules and Guidelines**

**1. Introduction**

- 1.1 The annual Scout Raffle Campaign will be held to raise funds to help our Units of the Association.
- 1.2 Approval has been given by the Chief Officer for Office of the Licensing Authority to the Association to conduct the Scout Raffle Campaign in early 2025. The Lottery Licence Number is 4930.

**2. Distribution of Raffle Tickets**

- 2.1 Participation in the Scout Raffle Campaign is absolutely voluntary. Participants must comply with the licence conditions.
- 2.2 Raffle tickets will be distributed to participating Scout Groups, Scout Leaders and Lay Members of the Silver Jubilee District by the District Clerical Support Team.
- 2.3 No Raffle ticket should be sold or offered for sale in public places such as roads, streets, pavements, footbridges, paths, lanes, alleys, squares or courts in the control of or which is the property of the Government. The same restriction applies even if the Group/District is using such places (e.g. community centre) for meeting or activity. Except with the permission of the owner or other person with lawful authority to give the required permission, no Raffle ticket shall be sold to any person in any privately owned public place (e.g. restaurant, café, square, etc.). **It is an offence for such contravention.** Violation of any licence conditions may result in revocation of the Lottery Licence granted to the Association.

**3. Selling Price**

- 3.1 Each Raffle ticket is to be sold at HK\$10 as printed on the ticket.
- 3.2 According to the licence conditions, the price of Raffle ticket must not be changed. **It is a criminal offence to sell the ticket at a different price or to re-sell the ticket.**

**4. Selling Period**

- 4.1 The selling period is from 19 January 2025 (Sunday) to 7 March 2025 (Friday).
- 4.2 According to the licence conditions, Raffle tickets must not be sold outside this period (i.e. earlier or after this period).

**5. Criteria for Participation**

To qualify for participating in this year's Campaign,

- 5.1 For Group: must have submitted its audited 2023/2024 Statement of Account to the District Commissioner pursuant to the relevant provisions of "Policy, Organisation and Rules" and have returned all Raffle proceeds and unsold Raffle tickets of the Scout Raffle Campaign 2024 on time; but the aforesaid criteria may be waived for new Groups registered on or after 1 June 2023.
- 5.2 For Silver Jubilee District: must have submitted its audited 2023/2024 Statement of Account to the Deputy Chief Commissioner (Operations).

- 5.3 If a Group/District fails to submit an audited Annual Statement of Account and return Raffle proceeds and/or unsold Raffle tickets on time or fails to comply with the licence conditions, the Association may bar them from participating in future Scout Raffle Campaign or other fund-raising activities of the Association.

## 6. Distribution Arrangements

- 6.1 The District Clerical Support Team is responsible for distributing Raffle tickets to Lay Members, Uniformed Members and Groups of the Silver Jubilee District.
- 6.2 The distribution will be made in early January 2025.
- 6.3 As the selling period is short, participating Groups are reminded to distribute Raffle tickets to their members at the earliest possible time.
- 6.4 Upon receipt of Raffle tickets, the Group Scout Leader or Scouter-in-charge is required to sign a declaration on behalf of the Group to signify the agreement to comply with the rules of the Scout Raffle Campaign.
- 6.5 The Group Scout Leader or Scouter-in-charge is required to inform the Group members details of the Scout Raffle Campaign including the selling period, selling price, Raffle stubs collection arrangement, means to return Raffle proceeds and/or unsold Raffle tickets, etc and ensure that they fully understand and comply with the arrangements. A sample of “Notes on the Arrangements for the Scout Raffle Campaign 2025” is attached as an Annex for use when necessary. Please keep a copy of the ticket distribution list for reference.

## 7. Allocation of Raffle proceeds

- 7.1 15% of the proceeds will be set aside to meet administrative expenses of the Campaign including purchase of prizes. Surplus, if any, will be credited to the “Scout Development Funding Scheme” which will be used for promotion of Scouting and membership growth.
- 7.2 Raffle proceeds will be allocated as follows:-

- 7.3 **If a District staff/Lay Member/Group fails to return Raffle proceeds and/or unsold Raffle tickets on or before the specified date, the Raffle tickets will be regarded as sold. The corresponding amount will be deducted from Raffle proceeds to be released to the Group/District concerned.**
- 7.4 **Donations related to the Scout Raffle Campaign will be used to meet administrative expenses of the Campaign including purchase of prizes.**

## 8. Criteria for Release of Raffle proceeds

- 8.1 Participating Group/District should have a bank account in the name of the Group/District and submit the audited 2024/2025 Statement of Account to the District Commissioner/ Deputy Chief Commissioner (Operations) on or before the specified date.
- 8.2 On condition that the criteria set out in section 8.1 are met, Raffle proceeds will be released to participating Group/District as follows:

Date of Submission of 2024/2025 Statement of Account with a Valid Bank Account	Date for Crediting Raffle Proceeds
Before 30 June 2025 (Monday)	July 2025
Before 31 October 2025 (Friday)	November 2025

8.3 If a Group/District fails to submit its audited 2024/2025 Statement of Account to the District Commissioner/Deputy Chief Commissioner (Operations) or does not have a valid bank account before 31 October 2025 (Friday), the relevant Raffle proceeds will be appropriated to the “Scout Development Funding Scheme”.

## 9. Raffle Stubs Collection Box

The stubs collection boxes will be placed at the Association Headquarters, Regional Headquarters, branches of PARKnSHOP or FUSION or TASTE or TASTE x FRESH or INTERNATIONAL or food le parc or GOURMET or GREAT FOOD HALL starting from 19 January 2025 (Sunday). All Raffle stubs must be put into the stubs collection boxes no later than 7 March 2025 (Friday) for the draw.

## 10. Raffle Draw and Award Presentation Ceremony

The Raffle Draw and Scout Group Award Presentation Ceremony is scheduled to be held on 15 March 2025 (Saturday).

## 11. Raffle Campaign Settlement Process (Return of Raffle proceeds and/or Unsold Raffle tickets)


Lay Members/ Uniformed Members/ Group Scout Leaders/ Scouter-in-charge should return the following items to the District Clerical Support Team for settlement on or before **5 pm, 16 April 2025 (Wednesday)**:

- (1) Transaction proof/document of Raffle proceeds, cheque or cash (see paragraph 12 for details);
- (2) Unsold Raffle Tickets (if any); and
- (3) “Raffle Ticket Settlement Slip”(S2).

*\*Please refer to paragraph 15 for settlement deadline in respect of Best Performance Award and Best Improvement Award participation.*

## 12. Methods of Returning Raffle proceeds

### 12.1 By Bank Deposit

### 12.2 By Cheque

The cheque should be crossed and made payable to “Scout Association of Hong Kong”. Please write down the Group/Unit name, contact person and contact phone number on the back of the cheque.

### 12.3 In Cash

Raffle proceeds in cash should be delivered in person to the District Clerical Support Team. Please do not send cash by post.

## 13. **Lost Raffle Tickets**

13.1 If a Member loses any Raffle ticket(s) allotted, he/she must report the incident to the Hong Kong Police Force. A copy of Police Report must be sent to the Administration Branch through the District Clerical Support Team within 3 working days after reporting. The Police Report should contain the Unit name, contact person and contact phone number, quantity of tickets lost and corresponding ticket number(s). The Member should return Raffle proceeds and/or unsold Raffle tickets together with the original Police Report, where applicable, to the District Clerical Support Team. Otherwise, the lost tickets will be regarded as sold.

13.2 The Raffle Ticket(s) lost before the Raffle draw will be announced as invalid by the Association.

## 15. **Raffle Campaign Best Performance Awards and Best Improvement Awards (For Scout Groups Only)**

15.1 To encourage Scout Groups to participate in the Raffle Campaign, three awards viz. “Best Performance Award”, “Best Per Capita Performance Award” and “Best Improvement Award” are set up in recognition of the Group’s efforts.

15.2 All Raffle Campaign participating Groups are eligible for these Awards. The assessment criteria are as below:

Best Improvement Award <sup>(3)</sup>	The increase in Raffle proceeds per capita from 2024 to 2025 <sup>(4)</sup>	Top 20 Groups

*Remarks:*

- (1) *Total Raffle proceeds in 2025: Only those Groups completed the whole Raffle Campaign settlement process **on or before 5 pm, 11 March 2025 (Tuesday)** will be considered.*
- (2) *Total number of youth members of the Group in 2024 is the number of youth members in a Group reported in Annual Group Registration & Census 2024. To qualify for the awards, the number of youth members of each Unit of the participating Group must comply with the minimum standards as laid down in Rule 2.3 of the “Policy, Organisation and Rules” of the Association.*
- (3) *Groups not participated in Raffle Campaign 2024 are not eligible for “Best Improvement Award”.*
- (4) *The increase in Raffle proceeds per capita from 2024 to 2025:
