E. G. Remarks: (1) Application result will be notified by email. Applicant has to provide email address.
(2) No refund will be made upon acceptance of application. The fee paid is non-transferrable.
(3) Participants are responsible for their meals.
(4) Participants should attend the course in full Scout uniform.
(5) Participants must attend all sessions of the course and pass the assessment in order to be conferred certificate. Early leave or late attendance is not allowed in any circumstances.
(6) This training course is subsidized by the "Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training". Therefore, 50% of the fee has been deducted for eligible participants.
