Purchase will be arranged by the Contingent Leader and the actual airfare will be confirmed by the Contingent Leader. All contingent members should depart and return according to the Contingent Leader's arrangement.</i>
Remarks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Age of participants is calculated on the 1st day of the Programme.➤ Each NSO can bring 4 patrols, each patrol consists of 1 Leader and 9 Scouts to attend the Jamboree.➤ Applicants are required to attend an interview for selection.➤ Applicants are required to possess a valid “Certificate of Swimming Test” when participating in any kinds of water activities overseas.➤ Priority will be given to leader applicants who wish to join the Contingent Management Team (CMT) of the Hong Kong Contingent. Please indicate areas of assistance you could offer to CMT in Part E (Skills & Interest) on P.2 of Form (IL/1).➤ The fee covers meals (Scouts and Leaders: from dinner of 11 Dec to breakfast of 19 Dec, IST: from lunch of 10 Dec to breakfast of 20 Dec), name tag, event scarf, first aid, programme, and inland transportation between Chattogram Shah Amanat International Airport (CGP) and Jamboree site.➤ Home hospitality can be arranged on first-come basis before or after the Jamboree subject to availability and arrangement of the host. Additional fee may apply.➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and travel insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference, any additional charges for offsite activities, personal and contingent’s expenses as well as expenses related to home hospitality (if applicable).
